SUBJECT

Establish the Morgan Stanley Power Purchase Agreement Memorandum Account.

PURPOSE

Bear Valley submits this advice letter pursuant to California Public Utilities Commission ("CPUC" or "Commission") Decision No. ("D.") 25-04-026, dated April 24, 2025.

BACKGROUND

On December 15, 2023, Bear Valley filed Application No. 23-12-010 for preapproval of the forms of certain power purchase agreements ("PPA"), preapproval of a benchmark price process for an energy product, authority to recover costs to an executed PPA, and establishment of a memorandum account to track unrealized gains and losses with respect to an executed PPA.

MORGAN STANLEY POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENT MEMORANDUM ACCOUNT

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. ("OP") 5 in D. 25-04-026, Bear Valley is filing this advice letter to establish the Morgan Stanley Power Purchase Agreement Memorandum Account. OP 5 states,

Bear Valley Electric Service, Inc. is authorized to establish a non-interest bearing memorandum account to track unrealized gains and/or losses regarding the executed Confirmation for either the Energy Product or Revised Energy Product BVES and Morgan Stanley Capital Group, Inc. ("Morgan Stanley") executed a confirmation (PPA) for the Energy Product effective as of June 1, 2025.

COMPLIANCE

The request being made in this advice letter is in compliance with D.25-04-026.

TIER DESIGNATION

This advice letter is submitted with a Tier 1 designation.

EFFECTIVE DATE

BVES respectfully request this advice letter become effective on May 28, 2025.

NOTICE AND PROTESTS

A protest is a document objecting to the granting in whole or in part of the authority sought in this advice letter. A response is a document that does not object to the authority sought, but nevertheless presents information that the party tendering the response believes would be useful to the CPUC in acting on the request.

A protest must be mailed within 20 days of the date the CPUC accepts the advice letter for filing. The Calendar is available on the CPUC's website at <u>www.cpuc.ca.gov</u>.

A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter.

The utility must respond to a protest within five days.

1.	<u>PURPOSE</u> The purpose of the MSPPAMA is to track the unrealized gains and losses otherwise imputed to the Morgan Stanley Power Purchase Agreement as a consequence of complying with Accounting Standards Codification ("ASC") No. 815 – " <i>Derivatives and Hedging</i> " issued by the Financial Account Standards Board. This memorandum account is in compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. 5 in Decision No. ("D.") 25-04-026.	
2.	<u>APPLICABILITY</u> The MSPPAMA applies to all customer classes, except for those specifically excluded by the Commission.	
3.	<u>RATES</u> The MSPPAMA does not have a rate component.	
4.	<u>ACCOUNTING PROCEDURES</u> BVES shall maintain the MSPPAMA by making entries at the end of each month as follows:	
	a. Entries shall be made to the MSPPAMA at the end of each month to record the unrealized gain or loss attributable to the application of ASC 815 to the Morgan Stanley Power Purchase Agreement, as authorized by the Commission in D. 25-04-026.	
	b. This is a non-interest bearing memorandum account.	
5.	<u>EFFECTIVE DATE</u> The MSPPAMA shall have an effective date of May 28, 2025.	
6	<u>DISPOSITION</u> At the conclusion of the memorandum account's operation, the account will be reversed and no additional costs will be recovered from (or refunded to) ratepayers.
