Bear Valley Electric Service, Inc. ("BVES") hereby transmits for filing the following:

**SUBJECT:** Informational filing for Decision 25-06-034 Ordering Paragraph 7 and 11

### **PURPOSE**

Pursuant to Decision No. ("D.") 25-06-034, dated June 12, 2025, and in compliance with Ordering Paragraph No. ("OP") 7 and OP 11, BVES is submits this Advice Letter to provide the required compliance report per Section 4.2 and Appendix A of this decision. This filing satisfies the Commission's directive to report any new electric service lines installed in new constructions and any electric service lines replacing existing service lines. This information is to be submitted via an informational Tier 1 Advice Letter by April 15, 2026, and annually each April 15 thereafter.<sup>1</sup>

*7. Appendix A to this decision is the Electric Utilities New Reporting Requirements and is adopted. Appendix A shall apply to all electric utilities, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, and San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Liberty Utilities LLC, PacifiCorp, and Bear Valley Electric Service Inc., and the reporting fields related to common facility cost treatment on Appendix A are only applicable to large electric utilities, and shall automatically sunset after the final report is submitted following either (a) the authorized funds having been fully expended, or (b) after four years, whichever comes first.*

*11. When installing new electric service lines or replacing existing electric service lines, Pacific Gas and Electric Company, Southern California Edison Company, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, Liberty Utilities LLC, PacifiCorp, and Bear Valley Electric Service Inc. shall collect service line capacities for (1) any new electric service lines installed in new construction and (2) any electric service lines replacing existing service lines; and the aforementioned utilities shall report this information in accordance with the requirements established in Section 4.2 and Appendix A of this decision.*

If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter.

The utility must respond to a protest within five days.
