A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter. The utility must respond to a protest with five days.

A customer applying for service under schedule "DLI" will be required to show proof of satisfying Special Condition #1 above and may be required to sign a form that declare that they are not receiving a baseline allowance at any other location (whether inside BVES territory or outside BVES territory).
- 3. Low-Income Household: A Low-Income Household is a household where the total gross annual income from all sources is no more than shown on the table below based on the number of persons in the household. Total gross income shall include income from all sources, both taxable and nontaxable.

NOTICE TO INVESTOR OWNED AND SMALL MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL UTILITIES PROVIDING SERVICE UNDER CALIFORNIA ALTERNATIVE RATE FOR ENERGY (CARE), FAMILY ELECTRIC RATE ASSISTANCE (FERA) AND ENERGY SAVINGS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (ESAP)

Energy Division is issuing this notice to update the income limitations for the CARE, FERA and the Energy Savings Assistance Programs. This notice is being issued earlier than in previous years at the request of the utilities to allow additional time for implementation.

The 2012-2013 CARE and ESAP income limits have been updated in compliance with Public Utilities ("P.U.") Code Section 739.1 (b) (1)¹. To better align the methodology Energy Division used in the past, pursuant to Resolution E-3524² to the requirements of P.U. Code Section 739.1 (b)(1), effective immediately and beginning with the 2012-2013 income updates, the correct Federal Poverty Guideline values corresponding to correct household size will be used to calculate and update the annual CARE, FERA and ESAP income limits. The Director of the Energy Division will continue to communicate new income levels to carriers no later than May 1st and require energy utilities to file revised tariffs effective June 1st of each year.

Please note, income limits for households with 1-2 persons are now correctly listed separately and will no longer be consolidated. Additionally, income limits are now displayed for household sizes of 1-8 persons in alignment with actual Federal Poverty Guidelines. The income limits below are effective from June 1st, 2012 until May 31, 2013 for all new CARE, FERA and ESAP program enrollments as well as CARE post enrollment verifications and re-certifications.

The income limits for 2012-2013 in compliance with Public Utilities Code Section 739.1 are as follows:

The Commission authorized FERA, also known as the Lower Middle Income Large Household Program, in D.04-02-057 on February 26, 2004. In that Decision, Findings of Fact 22, the

¹ The Commission shall establish a program of assistance to low-income electric and gas customers with annual household incomes that are no greater than 200 percent of the federal poverty guideline levels, the cost of which shall not be borne solely by any single class of customer. The program shall be referred to as the California Alternate Rates for Energy or CARE program. The commission shall ensure that the level of discount for low-income electric and gas customers correctly reflects the level of need.

² Resolution E-3524 was adopted on February 19, 1998.

Commission stated that the use of CARE procedures for annual income guideline updates is also reasonable for the FERA program.

In D.05-10-044, dated October 27, 2005, the *lower* income limits of the FERA program were raised to 200%+\$1 of the Federal Poverty Guideline levels, which correspond to the *upper* limits of the CARE program.
