**SUBJECT:** Request to Recover To-The-Meter Costs Related To The Upgrade Of Mobile Home Park Pilot Program And To Increase BRRBA Revenue Requirement

**SUPPLEMENT**

In the event the Commission issues a final Decision in the pending BVES GRC application (A. 17-05-004) prior to the disposition of this advice letter, GSWC will apply the Revenue Requirement for the TTM to the new BRRAM target at the first opportunity it has to do so, and will adjust base rates accordingly.

If this advice letter is approved prior to the issuance of the final Decision in the pending BVES GRC, then the proposed surcharges below will be implemented upon approval of this advice letter and will remain in effect until such time the TTM Revenue Requirement is incorporated into ratebase.

### **PURPOSE**

BVES is seeking authorization to include in rate base To-The-Meters (“TTM”) costs of completed, operational, used and useful metering of mobile home park coaches located at the Whispering Pines Mobilehome Park (“Whispering Pines”). BVES also seeks to increase the authorized revenue requirement of the Base Revenue Requirement Adjustment Mechanism (“BRRAM”) by the total amount of TTM costs incurred for the upgrades at Whispering Pines.

### **BACKGROUND**

On March 14, 2014, the California Public Utilities Commission (“Commission”) issued Decision No. (“D.”) 14-03-021, which adopted a voluntary three-year pilot mobile home park master-metered to sub-metered conversion program (“Program”). The Program’s goal is to convert approximately 10 percent of total mobile home park (“MHP”) spaces within each of the California electric and gas utilities service territories. The Program ran from January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2017.

Interested MHPs submitted their initial applications (Forms of Intent) to participate in the Program during the application period, which occurred from January 1, 2015 through March 31, 2015. The Commission vested its Safety and Enforcement Division (“SED”) with the authority to prioritize applications received for the Program based on risk assessment and other established prioritization factors. Beginning on April 1, 2015, SED started the process of priority ranking each energy utility’s Program applicants for upgrade into three Categories. MHPs that are ranked in Category 1 needed to be upgraded first. MHPs that are ranked in Category 3 are upgraded last. On May 22, 2015, SED selected a total of 4 MHPs located in BVES’ service area and ranked them by priority category.

SED directed BVES to upgrade the Category 1 Leisure Bear MHP first. Both BVES and Southwest Gas (“SWG”) serve the Leisure Bear MHP (“Leisure Bear”). Engineering design work was performed from May 2015 to August 2015 at Leisure Bear. On September 24, 2015, Leisure Bear MHP managers signed the MHP Program Application. Leisure Bear also reviewed and agreed with the “beyond the meter” plans and contractor selection. On February 23, 2016, Leisure Bear, through its parent company, Bear Valley Lake Company executed the Program agreement with BVES and SWG. The utilities informed the owner of Leisure Bear that actual construction work would commence in early April 2017 with the goal to be completed by September 2017.

In March 2017, the City of Big Bear Lake (“City”) informed BVES that there were serious structural code violations within Leisure Bear and that the City would not

provide any work permits until such time these structural items were corrected. On April 13, 2017, Leisure Bear MHP officially withdrew from the MHP Program. SED was fully informed of the situation and it directed BVES and SWG to upgrade the 250 spaces in the Whispering Pines Mobilehome Park (Whispering Pines), which is ranked by SED as Category 2 priority.

In August 2017, BVES and SWG began the upgrading of Whispering Pines. BVES shared the trenching costs with SWG. At the time BVES anticipated that it will finish the upgrade of Whispering Pines by the end of 2017, in compliance with D.14-03-021.

On December 20, 2017, BVES completed the upgrade of 250 units at Whispering Pines. The final inspection permits from the State of California Department of Housing and Community Development Division of Codes and Standard was issued on March 28, 2018.

D.14-03-021, Ordering Paragraph No. 8 states:

8. *Each electric and/or gas corporation is authorized to fully recover in distribution rates the costs of the conversion program approved in Ordering Paragraph 2, subject to reasonableness review. The following ratemaking is approved: actual, prudently incurred program costs shall be entered in a balancing account for recovery in the first year following cut over of service; "to the meter" construction costs must be capitalized based on actual (not forecast) expenditures at the utility's then-current authorized return on rate base; "beyond the meter" construction costs must be capitalized based on actual (not forecast) expenditures and consistent with their status as a regulatory asset, these costs must be amortized over ten years at a rate equivalent to the utility's then-current authorized return on rate base. Review for reasonableness of "to the meter" costs will occur in the general rate case where those costs are put into rate base. Review for reasonableness of "beyond the meter" costs will occur in the first general rate case after service cut over.*

### **COMPLIANCE**

This advice letter requests the recovery of actual TTM construction costs incurred for the upgrades at Whispering Pines. In compliance with D.14-03-021, these actual costs are capitalized based on the rate of return on rate base of 8.60%, as authorized by the Commission in D.14-11-002.

The total cost for the Whispering Pines Conversion Upgrade is \$3,831,265. If GSWC's request is approved, the authorized revenue requirement will be increased by \$535,910 on the effective date of this advice letter. The Base Revenue will be increased by \$0.00359 per kWh.

### **WORKPAPERS**

The supporting workpapers that are being provided to the Energy Division and Office of Ratepayer Advocates contain detailed calculations for the recorded capital costs, revenue requirement and rate design.

**BILL IMPACT**

The proposed rate adjustment for low income customers under the California Alternate Rates for Energy (“CARE”) Program and for Non-CARE customers are as follows:

**Adjustment to Base**

CARE customers: \$0.00287/kWh  
Non-CARE customers: \$0.00359/kWh

**NOTICE AND PROTESTS**

In accordance with General Order 96-B, a copy of this advice letter is being furnished to the entities listed on the attached service list by either providing them a copy electronically or by mailing them a copy hereof, properly stamped and addressed.

A protest is a document objecting to the granting in whole or in part of the authority sought in this advice letter.

A response is a document that does not object to the authority sought, but nevertheless presents information that the party tendering the response believes would be useful to the CPUC in acting on the request.

A protest must be mailed within 20 days of the date the CPUC accepts the advice letter for filing. The Calendar is available on the CPUC’s website at [www.cpuc.ca.gov](http://www.cpuc.ca.gov).

A protest must state the facts constituting the grounds for the protest, the effect that approval of the advice letter might have on the protestant, and the reasons the protestant believes the advice letter, or a part of it, is not justified. If the protest requests an evidentiary hearing, the protest must state the facts the protestant would present at an

evidentiary hearing to support its request for whole or partial denial of the advice letter. The utility must respond to a protest with five days.


