

Making Home EV Charging More Affordable



Presenting a residential electric vehicle charging program from Bear Valley Electric Service

As more Big Bear Lake region residents switch to driving electric cars and SUVs, it's increasingly important that they have access to affordable home charging. Bear Valley Electric Service's new Bear Ready Residential program can help.

Bear Ready reimburses homeowners for the costs to install the electric infrastructure needed to support home EV charging. All you need do is apply and, if approved, have an eligible electrical contractor install the electrical connections for EV charging. Note that EV chargers are not part of the reimbursement program.

And, Bear Ready Residential participants are eligible for special EV time-of-use rates to take advantage of the best energy prices to fuel their EV.

Here's How It Works



Submit an Interest Form requesting an application and apply.

2.

Install eligible electrical infrastructure for EV charging through an approved contractor.

3.

Submit your contractor invoice and receive reimbursement for the electrical work.

Eligibility Requirements

- Applications must be submitted by the property owner.
- Property must be a single-family dwelling receiving service from Bear Valley Electric Service.
- · Property must have a dedicated off-street parking spot reasonably accessible to the point of electric service.
